

Membership Application for the Season 2010/2011

We hope you enjoyed playing netball for Southdown during the 2009/2010 season – yet another year has passed so quickly. It is now time to re-register for the 2010-2011 season.

The membership rates for the new season are as follows –

Senior players aged 18 and over at 1 September 2010	£135.00
Senior players aged under 18 at 1 September 2010	£120.00
Junior players	£110.00
Hi Five junior players	£85.00

Please print and complete the attached application form and return your membership, with payment, before 1st July to Jill Booker at 13 Musgrave Avenue, East Grinstead, West Sussex RH19 4BP.

(Should you decide not to renew your membership, please could you confirm this to us by email. Thank you.)

Payment can be made in two installments if you prefer – ½ by 1 July and ½ by 1 October. Please send **both** cheques dated as above with the renewal form. Thank you.

The membership fee will include –

- Southdown Training from September 2010 to July 2011
- Entry into local netball tournaments
- Court fees & Umpiring fees
- Affiliation to England Netball

Please note that extra activities such as entry into the Sussex Satellite Academies etc, which also may need additional affiliation required to attend them, may incur an additional small charge. In particular, any High 5 players who wish to participate in the East Grinstead Junior Netball League will need to pay the appropriate fee set by EGJNL. This is optional and includes all courts, coaching, umpiring and match fees organised by EGJNL.

Netball League arrangements will be similar to last season. Girls playing 7 a-side netball (usually year 7's but also some year 6's, please confirm with individual coaches) will play in the Sussex League further details will be available shortly (once we get them!), other teams will play in East Grinstead on Saturday mornings as normal. The senior teams play on Monday evenings as before. Training dates will be confirmed by your coach via email.

As a member of Southdown Netball Club we do expect you to be committed to both the club and your team and would like to draw your attention to the following guidelines & responsibilities for players –

- You will be expected to play as a 'team', be supportive & encouraging at all times.

- You will be expected to be a committed member of the club and regularly attend training sessions, league games & tournaments. Where this is not possible you must inform your team coach at the earliest possible time.
- You will be expected to be responsible for investigating when, and at what time training sessions and league games or tournaments are on, and contact your team coach for clarification if unsure.
